Cuxton Parish Council hereby advise the electorate of a 30 working day period during which your public rights may be exercised. The Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014 as summarised in the Accounts and Audit (England) Regulations 2015 (Statutory Instrument No. 234), and the Code of Audit Practice require that:

Each year the Council's Annual Return is audited by an auditor appointed by Public Sector Audit Appointments Limited. Any person interested has the right to inspect and make copies of the accounts to be audited and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts relating to them. There is a charge made for copies. Any such inspection will need to work within any guidelines in existence in relation Social Distancing and related COVID-19 regulations. This may involve video conferencing and/or remote viewing of documents.

For the year ended 31 March 2021 these documents will be available on reasonable notice (on a working day within the hours of 10am to 12pm) on application to: June Nicholson (Clerk and Responsible Financial Officer) Cuxton Parish Council, the Pavilion, Recreation Ground, Bush Road, Cuxton ME2 1EZ (Working days are defined as Monday – Friday. They do not include Saturdays, Sundays and Bank holidays.) The inspection period commences on: 14 June 2021 and ends on: 23 July 2021
