

Fraudsters never miss an opportunity and the storm on Friday is just one of them. So,


beware of cold callers offering to carry out repairs. Below I have listed the guidelines again on how to protect yourself.



- Ask the visitor to return another time when someone can be with you.
- Get three written quotes.
- Ask family and friends for recommendations.
- Agree payment arrangements and start and

finish dates in writing beforehand, and never pay in full until you're completely satisfied with the work.

- If the price is too good to be true, then it probably is.
- Never feel pressurised and always remain in control.
