During November, Cuxton residents showed their respects for Remembrance Day through a variety of beautiful installations.

Members of the Cuxton Craft association, MHS homes residents, and the Academy of Cuxton Schools produced a spectacular set of displays for the village, some of which were even reported in an article from the BBC. (www.bbc.com/news/articles/cv2zl2d4655o)

The displays featured a poppy-covered bench and bicycle at the bottom of Tar Tank Lane, a wash of poppies outside MHS homes, banners and garlands outside the school offices, beaded poppies in the library gardens and even a whole school artwork event.

On Remembrance Sunday, representatives from the Scouting and Girlguiding associations, and the Cuxton Parish Council, laid poppy wreaths at the war memorial, during a moving remembrance service led by Rev. Roger Knight.


